What are they?

(other names: book clubs, literature circles, reader's circles)

- 1. Reading and thinking about literature.
- 2. Collaborating with others to **talk** about literature.
- 3. Sharing our thoughts, feelings and ideas about books and authors.
- 4. Learning more about books through talking, writing and projects.

What is the purpose?

- To enjoy reading.
- Expand our literacy.
- Build knowledge of authors and illustrators.
- Form our own opinions about texts.
- Share our ideas in a way that others can follow our thinking.
- Value one another's ideas (respectfully agree or disagree).
- Think aloud and build on each other's thoughts.
- Deepen understanding of text in new ways.
- Wonder about books and search for the answers.
- Think critically (higher level).

How do they work?

Approximately 1 month to complete. Reading every day. Meeting once a week.
